NOTE: Presentation of Exhibit and Trophy winners will be at 2.00pm at the Show Cane Exhibit, on Friday, 21st June 2024, with presentations also being made by participating sponsors.

Entrants MUST be present for the presentation of Winners of Exhibits and Trophies or their prize may be forfeited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Only cane varieties detailed in Section 8 and grown on land assigned to Proserpine Mill are eligible for exhibition at the 2024 show. This excludes experimental cane and all cane grown under permits. Please note that Q124 will not be accepted for the exhibition.
- **2.** Any exhibit in the judges' opinion containing a variety not representative of the variety or class will be disqualified.
- **3.** All Exhibits are to be cleaned of trash, neatly presented, with tops left on.
- **4.** Standover cane or suckers are excluded from all exhibits.
- **5.** The District Exhibit display of general milling cane (plant or ratoon) must be grown and selected from within the confines of each Branch.
- **6.** <u>All exhibits</u> must be positioned and cleared of identification marks <u>by 5.00pm on Thursday</u>, 20nd <u>June 2024</u>, prior to judging on Friday, 21st June 2024.
- 7. All competitors are excluded from the exhibit area from the commencement to the completion of judging. Failure to observe this rule may result in total disqualification of the offending competitor or group. Judging will commence on Friday morning at 9.00am and conclude at approximately 10.30am.
- 8. The judges' decision is final.

Exhibit Entry Sections Numbered 1 to 12

SECTIONS 8, 9 and 10 can only be accepted on <u>Tuesday, 18th June 2024 from 9.00am to 4.00pm at the Proserpine Showgrounds</u>. This date has been set so as to fit in with the CCS testing which will be carried out by SSP personnel using their Curtis Engineering Cane Testing trailer utilising Sugar Research Australia's (SRA's) Cane Maturity Testing process.

SECTIONS 1 to 7 are to be delivered to the Proserpine Showgrounds by growers from <u>10.00am</u> <u>on Thursday, 20th June 2024</u> and must be positioned by <u>5.00pm Thursday, 20th June 2024</u> in the Exhibit Display Stand with correct Identification Tags (Issued by Stewards).

Entry paperwork will be completed on-site and tags must be attached to all entries. No late entries can be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: times for accepting entries on both days have changed from previous years.

- 6. HEAVIEST STALK.

This section has one (1) overall winner, in addition to category winners. An additional point will be allocated to Section 12 and Section 11 (if applicable) for heaviest stalk in the following categories:

SECTIONS 8, 9 AND 10: Entries and delivery at the Proserpine Showgrounds.

CCS testing will be carried out by SSP personnel using their Curtis Engineering Cane Testing trailer utilising Sugar Research Australia's (SRA's) Cane Maturity Testing process.

PLEASE NOTE: Entry Condition for Section 8 is that entrants are only eligible to submit a <u>maximum</u> of <u>three</u> (3) different varieties/entries in this section. For example, you can only submit 3 entries in total – choose your own combination of the 3 you want to enter – eg: either A, C, F or C, D, E, etc.

8. HIGHEST C.C.S. Test in Two Stalks – Any approved variety plant or ratoon, per grower. Six (6) Stalks showing not less than 1.8 metres of cane with tops left on must be bundled and delivered to the Proserpine Showgrounds. Two (2) stalks will then be analysed by SSP and four (4) stalks will be used for display purposes.

- 9. HIGHEST Quantity of Commercial Cane Sugar in Six Stalks of Plant Cane of any approved variety. Six Stalks not showing less than 1.8 metres of cane with tops left on must be bundled and delivered to the Proserpine Showgrounds whereby two (2) stalks will be analysed by SSP and four (4) stalks will be displayed at the exhibit.
- 10. HIGHEST Quantity of Commercial Cane Sugar in Six Stalks of Ratoon Cane of any approved variety. Six Stalks not showing less than 1.8 metres of cane with tops left on must be bundled and delivered to the Proserpine Showgrounds whereby two (2) stalks will be analysed by SSP and four (4) stalks will be displayed at the exhibit.





11. CANEGROWERS Young Farmer's Trophy

Entrants must be aged **45yrs** or younger to participate in this section and actively sugar cane farming. Membership with Proserpine Young Farmers Group is not required.

Points will accrue from entries in sections 1 to 10 and will be allocated as follows: 1st Place – 4 points. 2nd Place – 3 points. 1 point is also allocated for each entry, in each section (1 to 10).

1st Place: Perpetual trophy & prize. 2nd Place: Prize. 3rd Place: Prize

12. CANEGROWERS Proserpine Insurance Trophy

Points will accrue from entries in sections 1 to 10 and will be allocated as follows: 1st Place – 4 points. 2nd Place – 3 points. 1 point is also allocated for each entry, in each section.

1st Place: Perpetual trophy and prize. 2nd Place: Prize.

13. Kids Cane - Under 18's
